A Method to defray the Charges that would attend such a Currency.

As it is propos'd Borrowing the Sum of 5880 /. Currency, as Per Contra, of the Loan Office; in order to repay it to the Office, it may be done as follows

By laying a Duty on all Rum, that shall be imported into the Province, which reasonably may be supposed 60000 Gallons a Year, at 2 d. Currency per Gallon. -
