goal for the same. He owns himself guilty of some of the same charged upon him, and says he had a partner, named Julian Giraudet, who is lately go in to seal. Bellec came from Lou burgh to Hallifax, and from thence to this town, a few months ago. He precends to be a protestant, and that he came here for the sake of religion; but we know of no article in tour creeds, or confessions of faith, that teaches us to break open warehouses, and enrich ourselves with the spoil of our neighbouts.

May 14. Last week three Frenchmen arrived here by land from Canada, with a packet from the governor there, to bis honour the commander in chief of this province; and by all we can yet discover, it appears that they are come on a very sleeveless errand; and 'tis generally thought, they have some-

thing of more importance in view.

Wednesday last capt. Ph lips sail'd for London, and 'tis said cerried off about fixty thousand of the dollars lately released from their confinement in the treasury.

By the last letters from Hallitax we are informed, that by the ship arrived there from London they had advice, that a regiment of foldiers, and 600 English settlers, with 1500 Germans would be fent over this fummer, and that they would have a man of war and two floops station'd there for their protection.

And from Annapolis Royal, that the French inhabiting those parts, had received orders from the governor of Canada, to leave their habitations, and come and settle there, which some of them had done, and others were preparing to follow them. [A good riddance of bad neighbours.]
