1700. At a Session of ASSEMBLY begun and held at *Annapolis*, on the 26th Day of *April*, in the 12th Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord WILLIAM the Third, of *England, Scotland, France and Ireland*, King, Defender of the Faith, &c. *Annoq; Domini* 1700, and ended the 9th Day of *May* following, were Enacted the following Laws.

C H A P. I.

Passed 9th of May 1700. *An Act for the Service of Almighty GOD, and Establishment of Religion in this Province, according to the Church of England.* Lib. LL. N° 2. fol. 372. REP. 1702, ch. 1, §. 21.

N. B. This Act, being laid before his Majesty in Council, was not approved in all it's Parts; and was accordingly sent Back, with Amendments proposed; which were accepted, and an Act pursuant thereto, passed the 25th *March* 1702: Whereby this Act is repealed.

This Act repeals the Act of 1699, ch. 44. A new Act 1704, ch. 24.

The Powers given by this Act to continue, after the Breaking up of this Session, until the General Assembly could possibly be convened.
