Resolved in the affirmative; and so the amendment proposed was adopted.

Mr. Barnes then offered the following as an additional section, viz.

“And be it enacted, That said court shall have power to summon witnesses, and all witnesses summoned to testify before said court, shall be allowed _____ per day for each and every day’s attendance, to be taxed and collected with other costs.”

On motion by Mr. Gantt, the blank in the additional section proposed by Mr. Barnes, was filled up with the words “fifty cents.”

The question was then taken on the adoption of the said amendment, and resolved in the affirmative.

On motion by Mr. Stricker, the following was received and adopted as an additional section to the bill, viz.

“And be it enacted, that nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to affect any power vested in the City Court of Baltimore.”

The bill, as amended, being then placed in the hands of the Speaker,

On motion by Mr. Brooke it was withdrawn from the chair for the purpose of amendment.

Mr. Brooke then offered the following proviso; Provided always, and be it expressly understood, that Calvert county is hereby exempted from the operation of this act.
