So it was resolved in the affirmative; and the bill, being so amended and passed, was sent to the senate for concurrence.

The bill, reported by Mr. Buchanan, entitled, An act relating to the proceedings of the levy court of Baltimore county, was then taken up for consideration; when Mr. Turner moved, and the question was taken thereon, that the consideration of said bill be postponed, and that it be laid on the table? Determined in the negative. The bill was then read the second time, and the question propounded, "Shall the said bill pass?" Resolved in the affirmative; and the bill was therefore passed.

Mr. Farquhar asked and obtained leave of absence, after Monday next, for Mr. Sappington.

The bill, reported by Mr. Buchanan, as chairman of the committee on divorces, entitled, An act to divorce William Scott, and Anne Maria Scott, of the city of Baltimore, was then taken up for consideration, read the second time and the question taken on the passage thereof? Resolved in the affirmative; and so the bill was passed.

A message was received from the senate, by the clerk thereof, returning the bills of the following titles, viz.

An act for the relief of Mary Davis, of Washington county; and,

An act to repeal part of an act of assembly therein mentioned; severally endorsed "will pass;" whereupon, it was ordered, that the said bills be engrossed.

Mr. John W. Thomas then asked and obtained leave to introduce a bill, to be entitled, An act to authorize the mayor and city council of Baltimore to grant divorces, within the limits of said city. Ordered, That Messrs. John W. Thomas, Tyson, Crabb, John Hughes and Stricker, be a committee to prepare the same.

The house then adjourned until Monday morning next ten o'clock.
