

Our Washington Letter.

From our regular correspondent Washington, Feb. 24, 1888

The Senate having removed the injunction of secrecy from the Fisheries treaty, the most notable thing done by that body this week was to debate for more than an hour the policy of considering the document with open doors.

So radical a departure from time-honored precedents awakened bitter opposition from a number of influential Senators, but there have also been a number of prominent converts to the open session movement of late.

It is predicted that the secret sessions, except where affirmative reasons exist for secrecy, will not last many months longer.

Senator Teller made a vigorous plea for open sessions recently. He argued that no Department in this Government had any business to have secrets from the public, unless it were the State Department, pending treaty negotiations, or something of that kind.

He said every decision made by the head of a Department, every adjudication made by the head of a bureau ought to be an open book for the people of the United States to read and examine.

He held that secret session were un-republican; that there was no more reason for considering the confirmation of executive appointments behind closed doors than for legislating behind closed doors; that it was one of the essentials of a free people that they should know what their public servants are doing, and he mentioned that even the Supreme Court is publicly recorded the action of each Justice on each question.

Probably the most notable thing done by the House this week was to defeat by a vote of 129 to 128 the House resolution changing Inauguration Day to the 30th of April, and extending the shortness of Congress to that date.

It now remains to be seen what the Senate and House together will do with the Crain resolution providing that Congress shall meet on the 1st of January after the election.

The deepest interest and sympathy is felt here over the condition of Mr. W. W. Corcoran, the venerable and beloved Washington philanthropist, whose long and useful career is rapidly nearing its close.

OUR ROADS.

Mr. Editor:—In this week Observer can be seen a letter on our county roads, the writer has drawn it mild, nothing has been extenuated or sought set down in malice; every word is true, only too true! 'Tis a pity it is true.

Our roads are a lasting disgrace to the fair fame of Queen Anne's county and uncalled, for by the present mode of butchering our roads there is money enough wanted to put them in good order.

The Commissioners should make and enforce a rule for working our roads and all workers should be held strictly to it. That rule should forbid ditches on the road and all roads should be rounded high in the middle with a gradual slope to their extreme width, the side drains kept clean, bridges well up and the roads widened and straightened were necessary.

Perhaps it would be much cheaper in many instances to abandon the old road bed and lay down a new one, for this everlasting ditching has washed the large portions of the centre of the roads.

Its an established fact that the winter roads the easier they are to keep in order besides they enhance the beauty of the country of which they form a part. Lanes are expensive and a relic of a Barbarous age. Those same old lanes or roads that were traveled 200 years ago were much better than those of to-day. There is two hundred times more travel now than there was then.

The county is more wealthy and prosperous than it was then, and our roads should be kept up to the standard of improvement that our rounds them. In the matter of roads we are behind our grand fathers time. In this age of steam, when every body wants to get right along. Its often a greater task to get to Centreville than it is to New York city.

The centre of our roads are basins for the horses feet and the wheels to work into a lobby. Many of our supervisors make two holes by filling one; lean on his shovel half of their time talking politics and enraging the commissioners, because his levy was not double what it is, and swearing he will never take another road—patches on the road until harvest then lets the road take care of itself. He balance of the year. But when the next year comes he again applies for what he is pleased to term a d— old piece of road gets it and goes home happy.

Now I think this old foggy style should be abolished; put the roads out in sections to nice but competent and responsible parties, put them under obligation to comply with the requirements of the commissioners as to the manner of working the roads, and let those instructions be printed on the workers road machines or scoops whichever they prefer and compel the use of a roller to pack them and mash the clods after they are properly rounded high in the middle.
