

the other county by the said channel: and where any ship shall ride at anchor in such channel, process may be served on board by the officer of either county; but if moored by any hold on the land, she shall be deemed to lie in that county to whose shore she is fastened.—1704, C. 92, § 3.

5. The bounds of Talbot, Kent and Cecil counties regulated, and a new county by the name of Queen Anne's county, constituted—1706, C. 3.

6. Somerset county divided, and Worcester county erected thereout.—1742, C. 19.

7. Part of Prince George's county taken off, and added to Charles county—1748, C. 14.

8. Prince George's county divided, and Frederick county erected thereout—1748, C. 15.

9. The division between Baltimore and Frederick counties, and between Dorchester and Worcester counties settled—1715, C. 12.

10. The justices of Dorchester county, enabled to lease out part of the Prison lands—1757, C. 12.

11. Baltimore county divided, and Harford county erected thereout—Nov. 1773, C. 6.

12. Dorchester and Queen Anne's counties divided, and Caroline county erected thereout—Nov. 1773, C. 10.

13. Frederick county divided, and Washington and Montgomery counties erected thereout—*Resolve of Convention, Sept. 6, 1776.*

14. No application whatever, from any county or counties, relating to their particular policy or government, or from one or more individuals, although the state be concerned, shall be taken in consideration during any future session, unless the same be preferred within ten days after the first meeting of the general assembly, provided that this resolution shall not extend to any case where the subject matter, or any material circumstance thereof, shall arise or happen during the session in which the application is made, and after the time limited as aforesaid.—*Resol. Nov. 1788.*

15. No bill or resolution grounded on any application included within the above resolution, shall be taken into consideration by either the senate or house of delegates, unless the same shall be transmitted from the house in which it originates within 14 days after the expiration of the 10 days given for making application as aforesaid.—*ibid.*
