8. Where any writ of *capias ad satisfaciendum* shall issue, poundage shall in no case be demanded or taken upon execution thereof, or upon charging any person in execution by virtue of such writ, for any greater sum than the real debt bona fide due and claimed by the plaintiff, amounts to, which sum the clerk or the plaintiff, his agent or attorney, shall make and specify on the back of such writ, together with a memorandum or note in case of penalty, that the growing interest is claimed till payment.—*ibid.* § 4.

9. On the service of any execution for money or tobacco, the sheriff, for the service of the same, shall charge and receive on the same at the rate of ten per cent. for the first 5*l.* in money or 600*lb.* tobacco, and the rate of five per cent. for the residue, in the same specie the execution shall issue for, to be endorsed as aforesaid.—*ibid.* § 5.

10. All estates not exceeding 30*l.* current money shall be deemed pauper estates; and the register of wills shall be allowed for finally settling the same 30 shillings current money, and no more.—*ibid.* § 6.

11. Actions ended before judgment or final decree shall not be recorded, unless at the request in writing of the plaintiff or defendant.—*ibid.* § 10.

12. No officer hereinbefore mentioned, under the penalty of 200*l.* for every offence, shall send out his fees on execution but once in every year, between the 1 day of Jan. and the 1 day of March; and the party charged, his body, goods or chattels, shall not be executed for any of the aforesaid fees, unless his account of such fees be delivered to him, or left at his place of abode, on or before the 1st day of May in any year.—*ibid.* § 11.

13. Surveyor shall not be paid for erroneous certificates.—*ibid.* § 12.

14. Sheriffs may at any time between the 1st May and the 10th day of August yearly (on notice that any inhabitant of his county, indebted
