

At a SESSION of ASSEMBLY begun and held at the City of ANNAPOLIS, the 24th day of May, in the 34th year of the dominion of the right honourable CHARLES, absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland and Avalon, Lord Baron of Baltimore, &c. and ended the 24th day of June following, in the 35th year of his lordship's dominion, *annoque domini 1749*, the following laws were enacted.

C H A P. I.

Passed 24th of June, 1749. An ACT enlarging the time for receiving and paying the public and county levies, parochial charges, clergy's allowances, attornies and officers fees, for this present year. Lib. BLC. fol. 465. Expired.

C H A P. II.

An ACT for ascertaining the allowance of petit jurors attending the provincial court, to limit costs with respect to witnesses, and for settling their allowance as to itinerant charges. Lib. BLC. fol. 466.

To be in force three years, &c. Farther continued by 1752, ch. 11, and 1755, ch. 9. Expired 24th December, 1758.

C H A P. III.

An ACT repealing part of an act, entitled, (a) An act to encourage the destroying of wolves, crows and squirrels. Lib. BLC. fol. 467.

(a) 1728, ch. 7. The present act to be in force three years, &c. Expired.

C H A P. IV.

An ACT to enable the justices of Baltimore county court for the time being to levy on the taxable inhabitants of the said county a quantity of tobacco, for the uses therein mentioned. Lib. BLC. fol. 468.

C H A P. V.

An ACT empowering the justices of Calvert county court to assess and levy on the taxable inhabitants of the said county a sum not exceeding one thousand pounds current money, and to empower certain commissioners therein named to appropriate the same towards building, finishing and completing, a new county court-house for the said county. Lib. BLC. fol. 468.

C H A P. VI.

An ACT empowering the justices of Baltimore county court to assess and levy a sum of current money, and for other purposes therein mentioned. Lib. BLC. fol. 470.

N. B. By this act, 1. Certain persons were empowered to sell, in fee-simple, the glebe-land belonging to St. Paul's parish, in Baltimore county, and to lay out the money arising from such sale in the purchase of so much land, in fee-simple, within Baltimore-town, as the said money should extend unto, and the deeds between the respective vendor, of the one part, and the redor, vestrymen and churchwardens of the said parish, of the other part, to be so worded as to operate and vest the said last mentioned land, in like manner, and to the like uses, &c. as the afore said glebe-land hath been. 2. The justices at November court, 1749, to assess, &c. on the taxable inhabitants of the said parish £. 250. to be paid by the sheriff, to the order of the persons above appointed, who were by this act empowered to purchase, in fee, in the name of the redor, vestrymen and churchwardens of the said parish, one acre of land, at or near the house commonly called the Red House, in Baltimore county; and thereon to build a chapel of ease to the afore said parish, &c.

C H A P. VII.

An ACT to take off the allowance for killing wolves in Frederick county. Lib. BLC. fol. 472.

To be in force for three years, &c. Expired.

C H A P. VIII.

An ACT for the speedy and effectual publication of the laws of this province, and for the encouragement of Jonas Green, of the city of Annapolis, printer. Lib. BLC. fol. 472.

To be in force till 25th December, 1750. Continued by 1750, ch. 20, and 1752, ch. 12, and expired 25th December, 1753.
