

1778. OCTOBER. LAWS OF MARYLAND.

At a SESSION of the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of MARYLAND, begun and held at the City of ANNAPOLIS, on Monday, the 26th of October, in the year of our Lord 1778, and ended the 15th day of December, the following laws were enacted.

C H A P. I.

PAID 15th of Dec. 1778. An ACT for the adjournment and continuance of several of the county courts within this state. Lib. GR. fol. 242.

C H A P. II.

An ACT for the relief of fundry of the inhabitants of this state. Lib. GR. fol. 243.

C H A P. III.

An ACT to prohibit, for a limited time, the exportation of wheat, flour, rye, Indian corn, rice, bread, beef, pork, bacon, live stock, peas, beans, oats, and other victual. Lib. GR. fol. 245. To continue until the 10th of May next. Continued by the act of March, 1779, ch. 10, until the end of the next session. Expired.

C H A P. IV.

An ACT for the relief of Joshua Chilcut, of Caroline county. Lib. GR. fol. 249. A Private Act.

C H A P. V.

An ACT to enable Cassandra Ducker, widow and executrix of John Ducker, late of Anne-Arundel county, deceased, to sell and dispose of certain lands and mills therein mentioned. Lib. GR. fol. 253. A Private Act.

C H A P. VI.

An ACT for preventing excessive and deceitful gaming, and for other purposes therein mentioned. Lib. GR. fol. 255.

To commence on the first of February then next, and continue three years, &c. Expired.

C H A P. VII.

An ACT to raise the supplies for the year seventeen hundred and seventy-nine. Lib. GR. fol. 261. Supplements March, 1779, ch. 11, July, 1779, ch. 5.

C H A P. VIII.

An ACT to prevent forestalling and engrossing, and for other purposes therein mentioned. Lib. GR. fol. 277.

To continue until the end of the next session. Continued by March, 1779, ch. 10, to the end of the next session. Expired with July session, 1779.

C H A P. IX.

An ACT to empower the justices of Dorchester county court to appoint a constable for the town of Cambridge. Lib. GR. fol. 285.

C H A P. X.

An ACT for enlarging the powers of the governor and council. Lib. GR. fol. 287.

To continue to the end of the next session. Continued by March, 1779, ch. 5, to the end of the next session, and by July, 1779, ch. 20, to the end of the next session. Expired.

C H A P. XI.

An ACT for the special appointment of inspectors, and for other purposes therein mentioned. Lib. GR. fol. 292.

To continue until the 30th of November, 1779. Expired.

C H A P. XII.

An ACT to revive and aid the proceedings of Talbot county court, and for other purposes therein mentioned. Lib. GR. fol. 295.

C H A P. XIII.

An ACT to empower James Sterett, Andrew Stigar and George Lendenburger, to sell and dispose of the estate of Christopher Limes, for the purpose therein mentioned. Lib. GR. fol. 297. A Private Act.
