BE IT ENACTED, by the General Assembly of Maryland, That an act of assembly, entitled, An act to prevent forestalling and engrossing, and for other purposes therein mentioned, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on Monday the twenty-sixth of October, seventeen hundred and seventy-eight, (b) be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force until the end of the next session of assembly; that another act of assembly, entitled, An act to prohibit, for a limited time, the exportation of wheat, flour, rye, Indian corn, rice, bread, beef, pork, bacon, live stock, peas, beans, oats, and other victual, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on Monday the twenty-sixth of October, seventeen hundred and seventy-eight, (c) be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force until the end of the next session of assembly.
