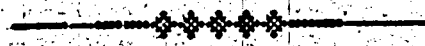

At a SESSION of the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of MARYLAND, begun and held at the City of ANNAPOLIS, on Monday, the 12th of June, in the year of our Lord 1780, and ended the 5th day of July, the following laws were enacted.
