venteen hundred and thirty-seven, (e) be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force until the end of the next session of assembly; that one other act of assembly, entitled, An act relating to guardians and orphans, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on the twenty-eighth day of March, in the year seventeen hundred and fifty-eight, (f) be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force for and during the term of seven years, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen after the end of the said seven years; that one other act of assembly, entitled, An act to exempt persons appearing at musters from arrest in civil cases, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis the tenth day of May, seventeen hundred and forty-eight, (g) be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force for and during the term of seven years, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen after the end of the said seven years; that one other act of assembly, entitled, An act for punishment of horse-stealers and other offenders, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis the first day of May, seventeen hundred and forty-four, (h) be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force for and during the term of seven years, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen after the end of the said seven years; that one other act of assembly, entitled, An additional supplementary act to the act, entitled, An act relating to servants and slaves, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis the tenth day of May, seventeen hundred and forty-eight, (i) be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force for and during the term of seven years, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen after the end of the said seven years; that one other act of assembly, entitled, A supplementary act to the act, entitled, An act ascertaining what damages shall be allowed upon protested bills of exchange, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis the first day of November, seventeen hundred and sixty-five, (k) be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force for and during the term of seven years, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen after the end of the said seven years; that one other act of assembly, entitled, An act to prevent certain evils and inconveniencies attending the sale of strong liquors and running horse-races near the yearly meetings of the people called Quakers, and to prevent the tumultuous concourse of negroes and other slaves during the said meetings, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on the sixteenth day of May, seventeen hundred and forty-seven, (l) and an act, entitled, An act to amend and explain an act, entitled, An act to prevent certain evils and inconveniencies attending the sale of strong liquors and running of horse-races near the yearly meetings of the people called Quakers, and to prevent the tumultuous concourse of negroes and other slaves during the said meetings, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on the third day of June, seventeen hundred and fifty-two, (m) be and are hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force for and during the term of seven years, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen after the end of the said seven years; that one other act of assembly, entitled, An act for the better regulating attachments, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on the fifteenth day of June, seventeen hundred and seventy-three, (n) be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force for and during the term of seven years, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen after the end of the said seven years; that one other act of assembly, entitled, An act concerning estates tail, and the jurisdiction of the county courts, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on the fifteenth day of June, seventeen hundred and seventy-three, (o) be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force for and during the term of one year, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen after the end of the said one year; that one other act of assembly, entitled, An act for the speedy recovery of small debts out of court, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on the sixteenth day of June, seventeen hundred and seventy-seven, (p) be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force for and during the term of one year, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen after the end of the said one year; that one other act of assembly, entitled, An act for the enlarging the powers of the governor and council, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on the eighth day of November, seventeen hundred and seventy-nine, (q) and a supplement to the act, entitled, An act for enlarging the powers of the governor and council, made the same session, (r) be and are hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force until the end of the next session of assembly; that one other act of assembly, entitled, An act to compel the attendance of the members of the general assembly, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on the twenty-third day of March, seventeen hundred and eighty, (s) be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force until the end of the next session of assembly.
