that another act of assembly, entitled, An act to regulate the criminal business in Baltimore county, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on Tuesday the sixteenth day of November, seventeen hundred and seventy-three, (e) be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force for and during the term of seven years, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen thereafter; that another act of assembly, entitled, An act for suspending the powers of the commissioners for building the court-house and prison in Harford county, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on Wednesday the twenty-third day of March, seventeen hundred and seventy-four, (f) be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force until the end of the next session of assembly; that another act of assembly, entitled, An act to regulate the militia, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on Monday the sixteenth day of June, seventeen hundred and seventy-seven, (g) and a supplementary act to the act, entitled, An act to regulate the militia, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on Friday the thirty-first day of October, seventeen hundred and seventy-seven, (h) and an additional supplement to the act, entitled, An act to regulate the militia, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on Tuesday the seventeenth day of March, seventeen hundred and seventy-eight, (i) be and they are hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force for and during the term of one year, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen thereafter; that another act of assembly, entitled, An act to authorise the lieutenants of the militia to appoint field-days, and to direct the payment and mode of recovering militia fines in specie, or the value, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on Tuesday the sixteenth day of October, seventeen hundred and eighty, (n) be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force for and during the term of one year, and until the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen thereafter; that one other act of assembly, entitled, An act to establish a market in Fredericktown, in Frederick county, and for the regulation of the said market, made at a session of assembly begun and held at the city of Annapolis on Tuesday the sixth day of November, seventeen hundred and seventy, (o) be and is hereby continued, and shall be and remain in full force for and during the term of seven years, and to the end of the next session of assembly which shall happen thereafter.
