

by reason all the Comissions for the Government since that time
relate to that Commission to Capt (None) is still in force Well
we are now willing and doo hereby take of that restraint and leave
it free to you our Lieut for the time being with the advice of
our Councill here to consent in our name to any act which
shall be agreed on by a Generall assembly there for payment
of Sutes and for imposing penalties on such as shall refuse
to pay therre Sutes, in as full and ample manner as you have
power by our Commission to assent to any other law in our
Name so ch^t shall be passed the assembly there —

2 - Item we command it to you care that an act of assembly be
speedily made for the Punishment of murder, Burglary
all other offendes whatsoever against the peace of the proovince
as Neare as conveniently may be to the Law of England for
we find there are noe laws as yet made there against
diers of those Crimis and Likewise for the Severe punishment
of all Contempts and misdemeanors in Courts of Justice by
standing (oures or otherwise) or against any Magistrate
or officer in or for doing his office and till an act of
assembly be provided for these last names Contempts and
misdemeanors to prohibit them by Proclamation and punish
the offendes by Imprisonment whipping or other punishment
not extending to life member Goods or Chattells according to
the power granted by our Patten of the said Province —

3 - Item we would have you to be very carefull in Causing alr^y
run away Servants from bing to be remanded to their master
and to procure an act of assembly there for some severe punishment
to be inflicted on all such as shall wilfully harbour or
receive them and by all meanes to keepe a firme friendapp
and Correspondence with the Governor Government and people
of Virginia —

4 - Item we recommend it againe to you, to be carefull that the Act
concerning Religion for freedome of Conscience be duly observed
and Executed by your seruos and all there under you —

5 - Item you are to be carefull to rectify an usuall Error in all
Bills of Lading falling Maryland tobacco, Bay Tobacco
and that all places be Called by therre right names in Bills
of Ex^t and otherwise and to see that the Proclamation
