

3^{dy} That notwithstanding any reservation made by his Lordship
or his Lordships Surveyor General for his Lordships use of any
Lands on either side of Mount Scarborough in the County of
Somerset within the said Province you shall forth with make
good all Articles made by our Dear Brother Philip Calvert Esq
on his Lordships behalf and Capt Edmund Scarborough upon
the laying out of the Bounds between his Lordships said
Province and the Province of Virginia in relation to the Granting
of any Lands in and by the said Articles agreed to be granted to
any person or persons whatsoever at the time of making the said
Articles so as the said Grants be made according to his Lordships
Condition of Plantation before his Lordships Instructions
above mentioned bearing date the 28th of July 1669 and so as
all Royal mines be accepted in every such Grant.

4th Whereas his Lordship is informed that his seal
for Annarundell County hath been put and is now in the
keeping of Mr Thomas Taylor his Lordships will and
pleasure is that the said seal be forth with taken from
him and put into the hands of Mr Samuel Chew
one of his Lordships Council and Inhabitant of
the said County of Ann Arundell and in those respects
more properly ^{English} for having the Custody of the same where-
-fore you are not to fail in the speedy performance of
his Lordships will and pleasure herein. Given
