Whereas Samuel Dornavan late of Baltimore County Yeoman was indicted for stealing and carrying away on the tenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight, two pieces of Muslin of the value of ten pounds Current Money of Maryland, and one piece of Linnen of the value of six pounds Current Money of Maryland of the Goods and Chattels of Seth Barton - and that on the sixteenth day of July in the year aforesaid on the trial of the facts contained in the Indictment, the said Samuel Dornavan was found guilty, and was adjudged by the Justices of Baltimore County Court to work and labour on the public roads or in making repairing or cleaning the Streets or Bason of Baltimore Town for the space of three years from said sixteenth Day of July - And Whereas a respectable inhabitants of Baltimore County
