Whereas an Indictment hath been  
 found in the Court of Oyer and Terminer &c for Baltimore  
 County at March term last against Benedict Hurst  
 late of the County aforesaid Yeoman for having on the

 current Money of Maryland, of the Goods and Chattels  
 of Joseph Vaughan - And Whereas it is represented  
 that the said Prosecution is a malicious one, and that  
 the said Benedict Hurst is a person worthy of the  
 Clemency of Government - I have thought proper to  
 order and direct that all proceedings at Law against the  
 said Benedict Hurst for the said Offence do cease and
