The State of Maryland To all our Bailiffs and good people to whom these presents shall come greeting.
Whereas Anthony Klunsmidth the late of Baltimore County was presented in several presentments at the Court of the said County at August Term Eighteen hundred and one for forgery and was by the said Court sentenced to work and labour on the public Roads of Baltimore County for the term of fourteen years, and whereas a Number of respectable Inhabitants of the said County have recommended the said Klunsmidth to the Clemency of Government, I have thought proper to pardon the said Klunsmidth for the offence aforesaid, and do hereby order and direct that he be released from the punishment to which he hath been adjudged, on this express condition that the said Klunsmidth do within forty days from this date depart the ~~United~~^{united} States and do not at any time hereafter return into any part thereof and if the said Klunsmidth do not fully and strictly comply with the condition aforesaid then this pardon to be null and void so no benefit or advantage shall arise to the said Klunsmidth from the same or any part thereof.
