

City of Annapolis February 8<sup>th</sup> 1804

Whereas John Foster of Baltimore County yeoman was presented by the Grand jury of the said County for breaking open on the tenth day of November 1802 the Store house of Samuel Brenton, and taking therefrom one piece of silver coin of the value of Eleven pence current Money, seven waistcoat Patterns of the value of five Shillings like money each and other articles of the goods and Chattels of the said Samuel Brenton, and whereas it has been represented to me by a Number of respectable Inhabitants of the County and City of Baltimore, that the said John Foster is of respectable connections and has always supported a fair and reputable Character and that they believe him to be innocent of the Charge, I have thought proper in consideration of his tender years to order and direct that all proceedings at Law against the said John Foster do cease and Determine, and that no further prosecution be had or carried on against him for or on account of the same, Given under my hand and the seal of the State of Maryland this third day of February Eighteen hundred and four
