Whereas William Warren of Baltimore County has been committed to the Jail of Baltimore County on a Charge of Stealing five Rock fish the property of Daniel Reynolds and whereas the parents of the said Warren have stated to me that he is about fourteen years of age, and a Number of respectable inhabitants of the City of Baltimore having recommended the granting of a nolle prosequi, I have thought proper in consequence of the youth of the said Warren and the respectability of his connections to order and Direct that all proceedings at Law against the said William Warren do cease and determine, and that no further prosecution be had or carried on against or concerning the same. Given under my hand and the seal of the State of Maryland this Seventh day of May Eighteen Hundred and four

The State of Maryland, To the Sheriff of Charles County Greeting. Whereas Negro Sam commonly called Sam Greenwell the property of William Wallace of Charles County hath been indicted arraigned and found guilty of Murder and by the Justices of the County Court judicially sitting at Charles Town in and for the said County the nineteenth day of March Eighteen and four was sentenced to be hanged by the neck untill he be Dead, there are therefore to will and require as also to Charge and Command you that on or before Twelve of the Clock on wednesday the thirtieth day of June next you take the said Negro Sam commonly called Sam Greenwell from your Prison and him safely convey to the
