

Annapolis December 2^d 1805

State of Maryland to Wit. Whereas Simon Wilmer of the City of Baltimore stands presented by the Grand Jury of Baltimore County for forging a note on John Gibson and negotiating it to a certain Nathan Syson and whereas a number of respectable persons inhabitants of the City of Baltimore have stated to me that the said Wilmer has always supported a fair and honourable character and have prayed the granting of an *Acti Prosequi* in his favour: I have thought proper to order and direct that all proceedings at law against the said Simon Wilmer do cease and determine and that no further prosecution be had or carried on against him for or concerning the same. Given under my hand and the seal of the State of Maryland this twenty second day of December eighteen hundred and four.
