presented by the Grand Jury attending the
Court of the said County at March Term
Instant, for stealing on the second day
of March 1805. one small cart-load of
Hoop poles of the value of ten Shillings cur-
rent money of the goods and chattels of Thomas
Russell. And whereas Tobias Rudolph
and Stephen Hyland, Esquires, Associate
Justices of Cecil County Court have certified
to me that they have been acquainted with
the said George Cully for many years, and
that they always considered him as an honest
and upright Man; and whereas the said
Grand Jury have in consequence of Informa-
tion which came to their knowledge
subsequent to the finding the said
presentment, and which could not have
been received as legal evidence, recom-
