

Bank of Maryland, and the Bank of Discount and
Deposit at Baltimore together with E. Mackall,
Cagart and Calwell, and a number of respectable
persons, Inhabitants of the City of Annapolis and
Baltimore, have stated to me that from the
whole of the Circumstances attending the trans-
action of which the said Wilkinson has been accused,
it is their opinion he intended to meet the Note,
negotiated at the said Bank, and that they have
understood that his Character has heretofore
stood fair and have recommended the granting
a Noli prosequi; I have therefore from these Circum-
stances as on account of his respectable Father
(and Mother and other connections, thought proper
to order and direct that all proceedings at Law
against the said James J. Wilkinson do cease
and determine, and that no further Prosecution
be had or carried on against him for or concern-
