I have therefore thought proper to order and direct that all proceedings at Law against the said William Wells ~~deceased~~ determine and that no further prosecution be had or carried on against him for or concerning the same Given under my hand and the seal of the State of Maryland this ~~Twenty~~ twenty fifth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight Hundred and seven
