The State of Maryland to Wit Whereas at a
Court of Oyer and Terminer and Goal Delivery
Baltimore County at July term Instant Thomas
has been presented by the Grand Jury of the said
County in three several instances as follows to Wit -
The first for receiving on the third day of July eighteen
Hundred and Seven two pieces of Muslin of the value
forty Shillings current money of Maryland of the goods
and chattels of Bolton Jackson from a certain negro
man named Caleb knowing them to be stolen -
The second for receiving from a Person Unknown on the
Third day of July eighteen Hundred and Seven
pair of Stockings of the value of fifteen Shillings
three Summs of Paper of the value of four Pounds
