I have therefore thought proper to pardon the said Negro Ceasar for the offence aforesaid and do hereby order and direct that he be released from the service to which he hath been adjudged. Given under my hand and the seal of the State of Maryland at the City of Annapolis, this fourth day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight Hundred and seven.

The State of Maryland do Wit whereas Margaret Tate wife of Thomas Tate of Baltimore County has been recognized to appear before the Justices of the Court of Oyer and Terminer and Good Delivery for Baltimore County on the second Monday in July Instant to answer to all such matters and things as shall be objected against her for receiving a quantity of stolen goods from Negro Caleb Daugherty Slave belonging to Mr Walter Simpson the owner unknown. and whereas it has been stated to me by persons of great respectability that the said Margaret Tate purchased the said goods without knowing them to be stolen: I have therefore thought proper to order and direct that all proceedings at law against the said Margaret Tate do cease and determine and that no further prosecution be had or carried on against her for or on account of
