

The State of Maryland to Wit Whereas Joseph Fowler
and Jesse Fowler were at October Term eighteen Hundred
and six indicted in Calvert County Court for stealing
a small quantity of Bricks to wit, Joseph Fowler two
Hundred, and Jesse Fowler three Hundred, and whereas
it has been represented to me, by some of the Jurors and
a number of the respectable Inhabitants of said County
that the said Joseph and Jesse Fowlers had no interest
in stealing the same Bricks. That they considered the
Bricks under the direction of a Mr Lawrence, who had
undertaken to build the new Jail which they were to
have assisted said Lawrence in doing and that they took
the Bricks with intent to account for them with
said Lawrence and without any intent to steal them,
I have therefore thought proper to order and direct that
all Proceedings at law against the said Joseph and Jesse
Fowlers do cease and determine and that no further
prosecution be had or carried on against them for or on
account of the said offences. Given under my hand

Annapolis this eighteenth day of December in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
