in the County aforesaid the common place of execution of Malefac-
tors and there the said William Robinson hang by the neck
on the said Gallows untill he be dead. for all which this shall
be your sufficient power and authority. Given under my hand

in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight Hundred and eight
