The State of Maryland to all our Bailiffs and
Good People to whom these Presents shall come Greeting
Whereas Zachariah Smith has been found guilty
in two cases for Felony and was by the Court of Oyer
and Terminer and Gaol Delivery for Baltimore
County at September Term last sentenced to serve
and labour on the on the Publick roads of Baltimore
County and so forth for the term of three months in
in each case amounting for the whole to the term
of six months - and whereas it has been represented
to me that the said Zachariah Smith is a youth
of sixteen years of age - and whereas the whole of the
Petit Jury who sat on the trials, together with the
Prosecutor of said County have recommended the
said Smith to me as a fit object for the interposition
of Government. I have therefore thought Proper
to Pardon the said Zachariah Smith for the offen-
ces aforesaid and do hereby order and direct that
he be released from the service to which he hath
