

The State of Maryland to wit. Whereas Louis Henry Charles Bepon has been indicted in Baltimore County Court of Oyer & Terminer and Gaol Delivery at September Term last for stealing a Pocket Book of the Value of five shillings current money of Maryland of the goods and Chattells of Basil S. Elder and whereas the said Bepon is stated to be a french youth who has lately arrived in the United States and to be of respectable connexions has petitioned for a Nolle Prosequi on condition of his leaving the United States - and whereas the said Basil S. Elder the proprietor of the said Pocket Book has stated to me that the said Property has been restored and has united in recommending him to the Clemency of Government. I have therefore thought proper to order and direct that all Proceedings at law against the said Louis Henry Charles Bepon do cease and determine, and that no further Prosecution be had or carried on against him for or on account of the same: On this expresp condition that the said Louis Henry Charles Bepon doth within ten days from this date depart the state of Maryland and doth within sixty day from this date depart the United States of North America and doth not at any time thereafter return in any part thereof, and if the said Louis Henry Charles Bepon doth not fully and strictly comply with the conditions aforesaid, then this Nolle Prosequi to be null and void so that no benefit or advantage shall arise to the said Bepon from the same or any part thereof.
