eighteen Hundred and nine, of Stealing a silver watch
the property of James Vickers and was by the said Court
at the said term sentenced to serve and labour on the
Public Roads of Baltimore County and so forth for the
term of two years - and whereas it has been represented
to me by the honourable John Scott Chief of the said Court
that the said Samuel Hynds is a lad of about seventeen
years of age and that his aged Mother is about to remove
to the State of Kentucky and wishes to take her son with
her and recommends that I should pardon him on
condition of his leaving this State - and whereas Richd
Choat supervisor of the said Roads has certified that
the said Hynds has during his confinement conducted
himself well and has appeared to be truly penitent for
his transgression - I have therefore thought proper to
pardon the said Samuel Hynds for the offence aforesaid
and do hereby order and direct that he be released
from the punishment to which he hath been adjudged
on this express condition that the said Samuel Hynds
do within forty days from this date depart the State of
Maryland and do not at any time thereafter return into
any part thereof - and if the said Samuel Hynds do not
fully and strictly comply with the aforesaid condition then
this Pardon to be null and void so that no benefit or advantage
shall arise to the said Samuel Hynds from the same on
any part thereof - Given under my hand and the seal
of the State of Maryland this ninth day of April in
the year of our Lord one Thousand eight Hundred and
ten
