the offence aforesaid and do hereby order and direct that
he be released from the Punishment to which he hath been
adjudged immediately on the receipt of this Given under

day of April in the year of Our Lord one Thousand
eight Hundred and Eleven

Cecil County has been indicted in Cecil County Court at
April term Instant for killing William Gibson of said County
and whereas twenty three of the Grand Jury that from their
acquaintance with the said James Campbell and from circum-
stances which have since come to their knowledge they are obliged
to declare it as their belief that the said killing was accidental
and have together with a number of respectable persons inhabi-
tants of said County recommended the said James Campbell to me
as a fit object for the interposition of government, I have therefore thought
proper to order and direct that all Proceedings at Law against the said
Campbell do cease and determine and that no further prosecution be had
carried on against him for or on account of the said offence - Given under
