Hanson situate in Charles Street in the City of Baltimore was surrounded and furiously attacked by an infuriated Mob, in defence whereof several guns were discharged by said Hanson and his associates by one of which said Gale was shot. And whereas similar indictments have been Alexander C. Hanson Daniel Murray and other associates of the House who were honourably acquitted after a full and fair investigation. I have therefore thought proper to order and direct that all proceedings at law against the said Henry Lee, John Thompson, Henry Kennedy, David Hoffman, Horatio Bigelow and Samuel Hoffman do cease and determine and that no further prosecution be had or carried on against the said Henry Lee, John Thompson, Henry Kennedy, David Hoffman, Horatio Bigelow and Samuel Hoffman for or on account of the said offence.
