regrets the conduct which caused the Prosecution. And whereas
a number of respectable persons inhabitants of the said County,
have together with the said James Fowke prayed that I would
grant a Nolle Prosequis to the said Gerard Fowke, I have then
for thought proper to order and direct that all proceedings at
law against the said Gerard Fowke do cease and determine and
that no further prosecution be had or carried on against him for
or on account of the offence aforesaid. Given under my hand and
