

for twelve months on the above case and at the expiration of his
said imprisonment, that he enter into a recognizance on the sum
of one thousand Dollars, and two securities on the sum of five hun-
dred Dollars each to keep the peace and be of good behaviour
for twelve months. And whereas it has been stated by said Johnzee
and Elie Selby, that they have families who are supported by their
daily labour, and who are now suffering for the want of their
exortions, they would be enabled to make for them if at liberty
to do so, and that they are determined and most solemnly
promise to refrain from offences of this nature. And whereas
Mr Eli Hewell and a number of other respectable Citizens
together with Abraham Cline the person assaulted and beaten
recommended the said Johnzee and Elie Selby to clemency of
the government. I have therefore thought proper to Pardon the
said Johnzee and Elie Selby for the offences aforesaid and do
hereby order and direct that they be released from the confine-
ment to which they have been adjudged, provided they each of
them enter into a recognizance of one thousand Dollars each with
two securities on the sum of five hundred and fifty Dollars each
to keep the Peace and be of good behaviour for twelve months
