misdemeanors whatever that have arisen or may arise in Dorchester
County and to deliver the Gaol of the said County from all per-
sons confined therein charged with any crime offence or misde-
meanor and therefore agreeably to the powers invested in me by law
I command you as aforesaid that on Monday the tenth day of
August next you or any one or more of you attend at Cambridge
in the said County of Dorchester to deliver the said Gaol as
well of the Prisoner aforesaid as of any other prisoners that
may be confined therein charged with any crime offence or
misdemeanor doing thereby what to justice appertains according
to the laws of this state adjourning the said Court from day to
day as may be judged necessary. And I hereby command the
Sheriff of the said County that on the said day or any other day
that you may adjourn to he cause to come before you as well the
said Prisoner and his attachment as all other Prisoners and the
attachments. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my
