been orderly and pendent and have recommended him to me
as a fit object for the interposition of Government. I have therefore
thought proper to pardon the said Charles Wilson for the offence
aforesaid and do hereby order and direct that he be released
from the residue of the punishment to which he hath been
adjudged immediately on the receipt of this. Given under my

October in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and
