confinement; and I do hereby order and direct that instead
of the said Jane Clarke suffering death as aforesaid she
shall be confined in the Penitentiary for the term and in the
manner aforesaid. Given under my hand and the seal of the

year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteen.
