Whereas, by an inquisition held on the body of a
certain William Marrick of Baltimore County, on
the fourteenth day of November, eighteen hundred
and eighteen, it was found that the said William

Obed Griffith has fled from justice (and it
being of the greatest importance to society that
the perpetrators of such a crime should be
to condign punishment - I have therefore thought
proper to issue this my proclamation and
