

The State of Maryland to wit
Whereas Samuel Foxcroft has been indicted
in Baltimore City Court at November Term
last for feloniously stealing on the twenty
sixth day of November one thousand eight
hundred and eighteen One thousand and
sixty pieces of foreign pieces of silver coin
each piece of the value of one hundred cents
and one spy glass of the value of five dollars
of the goods and chattles of Samuel Franklin
and one pair of pistols of the value of five
dollars of the goods and chattles of Elijah B
Schriener. And Whereas the said Samuel
Franklin and Elijah B Schriener from
whom the goods were stolen together with a number
of respectable persons have recommended the said
Samuel C Foxcroft to me as a fit object for the
interposition of Government I have therefore thought
proper to order and direct that all proceedings
at law against the said Samuel C Foxcroft
for the offences aforesaid do cease and determine
and that no further prosecution be had or carried on
against him for or on account of the same. Given

12th day of December in the year of our Lord 1818.
