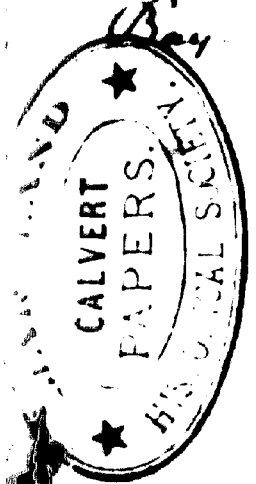


At a Council held at Ann Arundell 8. August 1659

Then was taken into Consideration His Lordships Instructions and Command to send to the Dutch in Delaware Bay sealed with His Lordships Province to Command them to be gone and ordered

That Col^l Nathaniel Utlie do make his repair to the pretended Governour of a People seated in Delaware Bay within His Lordships Province and that he do give them to understand that they are Seated within this His Lordships Province without notice given to His Lordships Lieutenant here and to require him to depart the Province

That in case he find opportunity he innuate unto the Dutch there Seated that in case they make their Application to His Lordships Governour here they shall find good Conditions according to the Conditions of Plantations granted to all Comers into this Province which shall be made good to them and that they shall have Protection in their Lives Liberties and Estates which they shall bring with them.

The Letter of the Governour to the Commander of the People in Delaware Bay

Letter sent by
Col^l Utlie
to Delaware

Sr I Received a Letter from you directed to me as the Lord Baltimore's Governour and Lieutenant of the Province of Maryland wherein you suppose yourself to be Governour of a People Seated in a Part of Delaware Bay which I am very well informed lyeth to the Southward of the Degree Forty and therefore can by no means own or acknowledge any for Governour there but myself who am by His Lordship appointed Lieutenant of His whole Province lying between the Degrees 38 and 40 but do by these require and Command you presently to depart forth of this His Lordships Province or otherwise Desire you to shew me Ground if I have any to the contrary. I am Sir Your Obedience under him
