our Government and Colony of New Amstelkland upon the same so foreward
Instruction shall demand the foreaid Place and Colony of New Amstelkland
upon Refusal shall Threatened the Governors Council and Inhabitants of
the Place to Blood in case that the foreaid Fortress and Colony is not rendered
willingly within the time and space of Three Weeks and to come again by
force of People to enforce the same by way of Hostility to invade the same
and moreover the Inhabitants of the said place Subject to the High and mighty
Lord States Generall of the united Provinces have sought to alienate and to
induce to Rebellion from their lawfull Commanders and our Nation which
is also directly against the Confederacy and Peace Articles between the Re-
publick of England and the aforesaid High and mighty Lord States Generall
of the united Provinces made in the Year 1654, and where as the aforesigned
Col: Nathaniel Little in his Discourse did make mention aifft. by you -
therefore was qualified and Commanded Which Never therell be any off the afo-
rementioned Instructions in no ways can be induced to Believe Therefor we
have to avoid all misunderstandings between these Government and People
and Subjects thought fit to send to you as Agents and Embassadors our well-
beloved and truely Augsteria Hermans and Revolter Walderom for to Mission
istrate all what is afo and how ill those odious Proceedings will be taken by
The High and mighty Lord States Generall The Lord Overseers of the
West India Company and the High Esteemed Lords and Governors of the
City of Amstelkland as they are taken now already so by us and to Request
for what is past in Reference to the Articles of Peace and in a kind and
neighbourly way the apprehension of certain Fugitives att their Conference
mighty to their Comission. These are only to serve for their address and
safe Conduct and we accordingly Request that the foreaid our Comissions
according to the right of Nations may be Credited and Believed as our
Truly Embassadors which we in like occasions at all times shall be
willing to acknowledge and remain in al other Observations which we
trust shall be accepted in all Cordially.
