 all th^e every & Offenders & Offenders w^{ch} Peace, & if yo^r see cause to put over th^e
 Offenders or Offenders w^{ch} good Surety or Sureties to appeare before th^e Court of the
 Counsell there, to answer th^e same. & in th^e meanes tyme to keep th^e Peace, or be
 of th^e good behavio^r, as th^e case shall require: And in default of such Surety or
 Sureties to be by such Offender or Offenders bound unto yo^r, to commit th^e Offender
 or Offenders to th^e common gaule, or next prison w^{ch} in th^e Province, as th^e
 yo^r shall see cause fit: There to remaine untill they find good Surety or Sureties
 as afores^d or untill here or there shall be delivered by th^e Court or th^e Counsell
 of th^e Province of Maryland or th^e greater part of them, wherof th^e Court
 for th^e tyme being to be one. And wee doe hereby further graunt unto yo^r, th^e
 every of yo^r full power & authority, to attach, arreest, or by yo^r warrant to cause to be
 arreest & detatched, & to bring to due punishment all Offenders & Offenders in weights
 & measures, all forestallers of marketts, regrators, ingrossers, extortioners, rioters,
 & other Offenders w^{ch} th^e publique wellfaire & peace of th^e Province of Maryland
 And wee doe hereby command all th^e Sheriffs, Officers, & Ministers w^{ch} they
 & every of them be obedient to yo^r th^e Province & every of yo^r in all things
 as becometh. Given under th^e great seale of th^e Province of Maryland at
 the Court of th^e Province, on th^e 18th day of September. 1644.
