Manners

It is ordered by the Court that the said Manners do deliver to the
 said Court the said 10000 and in the said Manners, when ever they shall
 come into the Province and that the said Court or some other person of the Court is hereby
 authorized and directed to admit the said Manners to all such persons coming
 into the Province and to take the said Manners and to take into the
 Court and to receive the same to the effect all such accounts and amounts
 shall be paid to the Court or some other person of the Court, and the
 Court shall be bound to receive the same when they shall be paid, the said Manners
 shall be as othe as any of them shall come to the Court.

The Court

It is further ordered that as long as you shall remain in this Province, when
 you shall return into the same to the Right Hon. Council Proprietary of this Province
 or his heirs, Executors, Assigns, or to his Governor, Thomas
 Manners Esq. and his lawful Assistants or Successors, or to the Proprietary
 or his heirs, Executors, Assigns, or to his Governor, as you shall know or
 shall be notified by any of them, you shall pay to the said Council, Proprietary, Governor,
 or his heirs, Executors, Assigns, or to his Governor, the sum of 24 pounds
 for every year. And you shall not bear any burdens or obligations, directly
 or indirectly, arising out of the public debts of this Colony to forgive the
 said Council, Proprietary, Governor, or his heirs, Executors, Assigns, or to his Governor.
