

Upon demand of <sup>John</sup> ~~John~~ <sup>Hallowes</sup> gent. admist. of  
estate of the Hon. <sup>John</sup> ~~John~~ <sup>Hallowes</sup> for 400 Tob. & 50 Corn & cloakes according to cus-  
tome of the County. The def. requires the Liberty of an admist. for a  
week or more by a day. The opinion of the Court was by the privilege of an admist.  
was not to be extended to this case of servants wages. And soe ordered that the  
def. should receive his wages according to the custome of the County. The 175  
Tob. to be respected according to the privilege of an admist.

Upon question in the Court what was the custome of the County for servants wages.  
The Court found one cap or hatt, one <sup>new</sup> cloak or five suites, one shoo  
one pair of shoes & stockings, one axe, one broad & one narrow hoe, 50 rimes

marks the demand of Dr. Hallowes 24. Decemb. 1675. Debit. due to the  
take of Tho: Purcell. who admist. he is.

Upon the demand above. The def. pleaded that the demand was made  
in the Provinciall Court, 2. March last. By which judgment he was dismissed  
and therefore requires not to be forced to answer againe to the demand.  
The Court finding upon Record the def. allega. to be true. Judged  
that of right he ought to be dismissed. & accordingly dismissed him.

Upon the demand of Dr. Hallowes 24. Decemb. 1675. The def.  
denied the debt. & the def. being tendered his oath, & refusing the same.  
The Court finding his oath upon oath. The Court found for the def. ac-  
cordingly. Executio ad scriptu: 22. Decemb. 1675.

that he this def. was sent when Dr. Hallowes made a bargain with John  
Norman. whereby it was concluded betwixt them, that Dr. Hallowes did pro-  
mise to take Tho: Olud in full satisfaction of his debt. the Dr. Tho: Olud  
owing Dr. Norman for much. if soe be Dr. Olud would confesse to  
be owed Dr. Norman for much. the Dr. summe he knoweth not. And
