Henrick Attorney of C<sup>ty</sup>: Tho: (Renewells) that of M<sup>r</sup>: Henrick rec<sup>d</sup>: is ordered of this Dep<sup>t</sup>:  
& byshards of Feb: 23<sup>th</sup> this Dep<sup>t</sup>: went to C<sup>ty</sup>: Renewells. to of M<sup>r</sup>: & byshards (after Capt: Jangle  
came to plunder of (bread) Ralph Beem: came to this Dep<sup>t</sup>: & demand<sup>d</sup> of Feb: 23<sup>th</sup>: to be carried  
aboard of M<sup>r</sup>: Jangle's ship. telling this Dep<sup>t</sup>: of Capt: Jangle had sent for it. To whom this Dep<sup>t</sup>:
