Be it known unto all men by these presents that I William Stone of the County of Northampton in Virginia Sheriff. by virtue of a Com. of Attorney from the Court of the City of London hereunder name made, assigned, & in my stead & place by these presents have put & continued my loving friend John Roper of Appomattock Clerk my true & lawfull Attorney for me & in my name to ask, demand, sue, recover, of Thomas Weston formerly of Virginia deceased, due to & against the Stone all such summes or summes of money, by bond, bill or account from the said Thomas Weston deceased. By writing & granting to my said Attorney full power and lawfull authority, to sue, arrest, imprison & condemn, & forth of prison againe to deliuer, & give a full discharge, & generally to doe all things requisite in the premises. And to make one or more Attorney under him, for the recovery of the above said debt or debts, as if I were in person. And I doe confirme & ratifie all that my said Attorney shall doe, or cause to be done by virtue of these presents. Witness my hand & seal the 22 day of July. Anno Domini 1647. & in my 23 year of our Regime of our Sovereign King Charles the first.

 Upon the demand of Mr. Edife agent of admistrals of Thomas Weston for cloathes &c. due
 for his service. Mr. Hatch deposed sayth, that he had received his knowledge received
 not more from Mr. Weston for his service than 3 barrels of wine, 1 wedding box, & an ar.
 The house ordered that the said should recover of the admistrals out of the estate of Mr. West
 on 337. £10. in consideration for his demand, for service.

Capl. Will. Stone being Attorney of Mr. Thomas Stone of London Sheriff of the County of Northampton. John Roper demands judgment against the admistrals of Thomas Weston March 2^o deceased for 135. £10. w. interest for 22 years
 Upon the demand aforesaid. Marke Thays Attorney of Mr. Henrick admistrals of the estate of Mr. Weston appeared. And Mr. Marke Thays upon specialty produced in the assembly, & a Com. of Thomas Weston under his own hand acknowledged the debt, (w. Com. & specialty appears upon Record) acknowledged 135. £10. principall debt, but denyeth the interest, the damages for forbearance thereof not being made appear. But alleged moreover, that he had not assets enough in his hands, whereas to discharge the debt demanded. And the house adjudged 2100. £10. w. at the rate of 1.2 p. The Admistrals Attorney declared to the house that the Admistrals had no asset of the estate by him, & he himself has it not & therefore craved leave to the liberty to give notice to the Admistrals in Virginia, if he may bring in his asset, & if he be not, nor execution may issue against the personal estate.
