said admiral's: in this part: of all crimes of Rebellion, Treason & Blaspemy  
& of all other offences w<sup>ch</sup> are of what nature soever committed in this  
part: against the Laws of the said admiral's: from the 14<sup>th</sup> Feb: 1647, unto the first day  
of Aprile last past. And of all Losses of life, lands, or goods, & of all other  
penalties incurred by the said admiral's: offences, or any of them. And I doe further  
declare in his name, that Every other person out of the said admiral's: acknowledged  
my sorrow for his fact, & requesting Pardon, before the feast of S<sup>t</sup>. Michael  
the Archangel, next, shall receive Pardon granted unto him, under my hand  
& Seal of the said admiral's: Excepting Reet. Jangle & his adherents. Given at S<sup>t</sup>. Mary's Church, Mart: 1647

Know ye that we in consideration of Francis Pope & John Courts of the said admiral's: of Maryland  
have transported into the said admiral's: in the year 1647, to plant & inhabit therein. And to the said admiral's:  
Francis Pope & John Courts may be enabled to doe unto us & our heirs occupable premises  
in the said admiral's: have of us the advice of the said Thomas Green Esq<sup>r</sup>: great of the said admiral's:  
And according to the tenor of the said order & seal bearing date at Portsmouth in the  
Realme of England the 13<sup>th</sup> Aug: 1647, & recorded by the Secretary of the said admiral's: by the said admiral's:  
& by these presents doe give grant & incorporate unto the said Francis Pope & John Courts, all the part  
cell of Land, lying on the West side of Poplar Hill; bounding on the West, with a line of market  
trees drawn out from a spring, called Popes Spring, into the second branch of Poplar Hill  
creek: On the West with a freshen called Courts fresh into a swamp of the said creek: On the  
South with the said creek: On the North with a line drawn out from Popes Spring into Courts fresh  
containing & are layd out for <sup>Three</sup> hundred acres, be it more, or less. And all woods, grass  
meadows, (Royal mines excepted) waters, fisheries & all other profits & commodities in or upon  
the said Land, having to us & our heirs & assigns the absolute & sole Lands & Rights  
of the said admiral's: To have & to holde of us with them the said Francis Pope & John Courts, & their  
heirs for ever. To be holden of us, as of a Manor of New-Towne in free & common  
tenure, by the yearly rent for all services, yielding & paying therefore yearly, at a usual  
receipt at S<sup>t</sup>. Mary's Church shillings in money sterl. or two Bushells of good Corn, at the  
discretion of the said Land. Given at S<sup>t</sup>. Jago's fort this 3<sup>rd</sup> Aug: 1647. Witness our hand & great  
Seal.
