Brens date for 3379. Tol: 6 9. Com: the date acknowledged 1559.
being due for surgery & physic to 5 soldiers of the Garrison. but for the one
part of the demand touching the p[er]ts salary, I did not find any thing due
him for the same. The p[er]t answering upon oath of satisfaction was given
by his J[ur]y for his paynes taking the same. The Jury found for the
p[er]t 500. Tol.

Upon demand of W. Harditch agt Thos: Popley, for one blackish pyed heifer
& her increase &c:
Robt. Smith deposed sayth That Thos: Sturmen had a pyed calf before the Rebellion in
country. & to his certaint knowledge there was likewise a pyed calf, of some years
Popes Hoar somtime by summer, w^{ch} was marked wth Thos: Sturmens mark: in y^e fl^o
flout, out of some other mark w^{ch} it had before. But what mark it had afore he
remembreth not. And further he sayth he beleieveth in his conscience of that calf
for mark: in Popes Hoar, was y^e same calf, to be known to have fallen of y^e fl^o the
Sturmens, before the Rebellion.

Anthony Rowland deposed sayth That y^e left side case of y^e pyed Beefe
in question between W. Harditch & M. Popley, Both ends appearing to be
cropt beside y^e fl^o. he verily beleieveth in his conscience was used for any
of purpose, by any one, but y^e it accidentally came to y^e fl^o crop.

Andrew Murrow deposed idem ad verbu^m y^e Ant: Rowland ut supra.
And the Jury found for y^e p[er]t & y^e Dkt to pay Court charges. And the Jury
ordered y^e it should be entered for y^e indymt.

Upon demand of Jn^o. Sturmen p[er]t vers. M^r. Thos: Popley deff^o Touching
the hearse Beefe. Upon motion of y^e p[er]t, not having witness put to make
it appear to be his; deff^o by y^e fl^o own may be respited till next Court.
